this book is about the experiences of a group of middle school students and the administration faculty and staff responsible for meeting their educational needs these students have been removed from the traditional public school environment and placed in an alternative school program in lieu of expulsion christopher dunbar jr urges educators and policymakers to reevaluate their goals and methods when thinking about what is best for these children

an in depth analysis of the contexts of black youth socialization with emphasis on the intragroup variations in the circumstances behavior and experiences of those youth taylor and his contributors present a balanced portrait of the majority of black youth who stay in school avoid drugs and pregnancy are employed and are not involved in crime despite social and economic disadvantages alongside those unfortunates who are enmeshed in the crucible of social problems authored by some of the best african american researchers in the united states this volume focuses on the multiple ecologies of black youth development from school through employment and marriage

discusses black children s experiences in and capacity to influence the physical environment of poor neighborhoods in the united states

many of the articles in this edition are new delving into such areas as welfare reform stress and male female relationships the movement to redefine the racial labels of blacks with a recent biracial heritage and sexual risk taking expanded sections on parenting marriage and divorce and family violence focus your attention on these key areas of current interest

deals extensively with the african american experience in the united states from the very beginning up to the present day with an in depth examination of the history and contributions of a people who want to be recognized

from concerns about juveniles incorrigibility at the turn of the century to school violence in the 1990s adults have attempted to understand control and prevent juvenile violence this work provides a historical overview of many significant time periods and includes entries about many types of juvenile violence

far more than an assembly of essays i have risen showcases a community of black youth of outstanding promise shattering stereotypes of race and class the book highlights the stories of fifty leaders who have translated devastating personal hardship into an unrelenting commitment to bettering their communities by turn heartwarming and heartbreaking these essays shine a light onto the thoughts of young african american scholars who promise to one day rock the world

deindustrialization white flight and inner city poverty have spelled trouble for baltimore schools marion orr now examines why school reform has been difficult to achieve there revealing the struggles of civic leaders and the limitations placed on baltimore s african american community as each has tried to rescue a failing school system examining the interplay between government and society orr presents the first systematic analysis of social capital both within the african american community black social capital and outside it where social capital crosses racial lines orr shows that while black social capital may have created solidarity against white domination in baltimore it hampered african american leaders capacity to enlist the cooperation from white corporate elites and suburban residents needed for school reform orr examines social capital at the neighborhood level in elite level interactions and in intergovernmental relations to argue that black social capital doesn t necessarily translate into the kind of intergroup coalition needed to bring about school reform he also includes an extensive historical survey of the black community showing how distrust engendered by past black experiences has hampered the formation of significant intergroup social capital the book features case studies of school reform activity including the first analysis of the politics surrounding baltimore s decision to hire a private for profit firm to operate nine of its public schools these cases illuminate the paradoxical aspects of black social capital in citywide school reform while offering critical perspectives on current debates about privatization site based management and other reform alternatives orr s book challenges those who argue that social capital alone can solve fundamentally political problems by purely social means and questions the efficacy of either privatization or black community power to reform urban schools black

social capital offers a cogent conceptual synthesis of social capital theory and urban regime theory that demonstrates the importance of government politics and leadership in converting social capital into a resource that can be mobilized for effective social change

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
